# **Notice of Race**

The Yacht Club of Egypt - Alexandria (the Organising Authority) in co-operation with the Egyptian Naval Force, the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport, and the Egyptian Sailing Federation and Water Skiing are pleased to invite the sailors to take part in Alexandria International October Regatta to be held at Yacht Club of Egypt – Alexandria from September, 29th – October, 4th 2024.

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- **1.2** In all rules governing this regatta:
- **1.2.1** [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- **1.2.2** [SP] denotes a rule which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing, or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
- **1.3** The Class Rules of the relevant Classes will apply.
- **1.4** No Class Rule change will apply.
- **1.5** The language of the regatta will be English. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

# 2. [DP][NP] Advertising and identification

2.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and/or advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority – see RRS 6 and the World Sailing Advertising Code.

#### 3. Eligibility and entry

- **3.1** The Alexandria International Regatta will be held to the following classes:
  - ILCA 4
  - ILCA 6
  - Optimist
- **3.2** The regatta is open to boats and to competitors who comply with RRS 6 and World Sailing Eligibility Code.
- **3.3** Competitors may enter by completing their entry form (attached) no later than 1<sup>st</sup> of September, 2024.
- **3.4** In addition to the requirement of 3.2, competitors and support persons (team leaders, coaches, supporters, family members...etc.) shall deliver signed entry form and register at the Race Office no later than 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.

**3.5** Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a completed and signed parent (or guardian) consent declaration form (attached).

# 4. Categorization

**4.1** No categorization requirements will apply.

#### 5. Fees

- **5.1** fees will be \$150 for competitors.
- **5.2** \$100 Damage deposit (refundable) per boat (ILCA or Optimist).
- **5.3** \$50 per person/ supporting team.
- **5.4** \$100 ILCA 4 and/or ILCA 6 boat chartering.
- **5.4** \$50 Optimist boat chartering.

- **6.2** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:30.
- **6.3** No more than three races shall be sailed each day.

# 7. Sailing Instructions

**7.1** Sailing instructions will be available during registration at the Race Office. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

#### 9. The Course

- **9.1** The course types will be the Olympic trapezoid and/or Windward-Leeward courses and/or Optimist Class Course.
- **9.2** Course will be set with each race planned to be approximately 40 50 minutes duration.

#### 10. Penalty System

- **10.1** Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.
- **10.2** RRS P 2.3 will not apply and RRS P 2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

#### 11. Scoring

- **11.1** The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply.
- **11.2** There will be 11 races in each class.
- **11.3** At least 3 races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta.

#### **11.4** Discard

• When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores.

• When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 12. (DP) (NP) Support Person Vessel

**12.1** Registered support person vessels shall:

Fly a flag with their three letter national code (see RRS G1.1) clearly displayed.

- **12.2** When flag Y is displayed on the Signal Boat or ashore, Rule 40 applies also for support person vessels life jackets shall be worn at all times when afloat.
- **12.3** In accordance with RRS 37 all registered support person vessels shall act as assistance / rescue boats in case of need and shall comply with any instruction given by the Race Committee or the Organising Authority.

#### 13. Prizes

**13.1** Prizes will be awarded as follows:

#### **Optimist:**

- **Overall Places**; First place Second place and Third Place.
- **Junior**; First place Second place and Third Place.
- **Girls**; First place Second place and Third Place.

# **ILCA 4:**

- **Overall Places**; First place Second place and Third Place.
- **Girls**; First place Second place and Third Place.

#### ILCA 6:

- **Overall Places**; First place Second place and Third Place.
- **Girls**; First place Second place and Third Place.

#### 14. Disclaimer of liability and Risk Statement

**14.1** Competitors and support team participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 3, Decision to Race. Sailing is by its nature an

unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event,

each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

1. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept

responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk

whilst taking part in the event;

2. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other

property whether afloat or ashore;

3. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their

own actions or omissions;

**4.** By participating in any race, they are satisfied that their boat is in good order, equipped to

sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

14.2 The Organising Authority and all parties involved in the regatta organisation will not

accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction

with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
